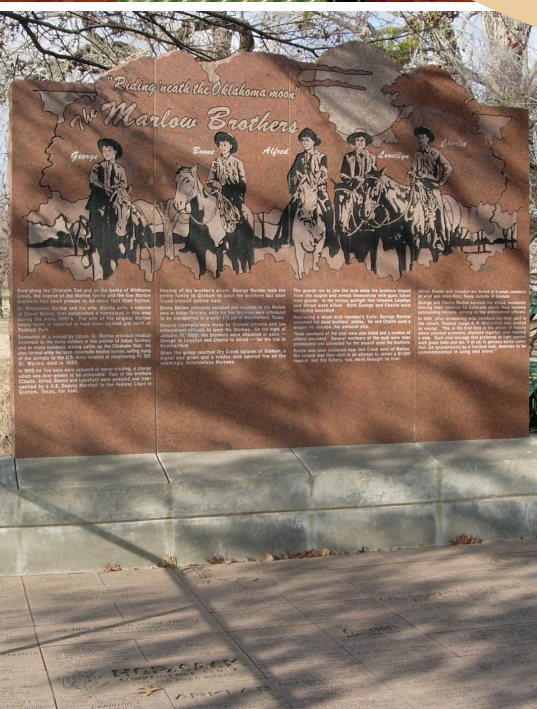




# VISIT DUNCAN OKLAHOMA
